How We Take Our Medicine: Revolutions in Drug Treatment Delivery

Working at the intersection of nanotechnology, biology, medicine and engineering, Victor Rodgers is working toward the development of new transplantable devices and more effective methods for delivering specific drugs and nutrients to targeted sites in the body.

Although a chemical engineer by training, Professor Rodgers has concentrated on applying chemical engineering to the development and better understanding of bio-medical and biological systems. His current collaborative research focuses on the development of medical devices to reduce edema and provide drug delivery for severe stroke, severe spinal cord injuries, and traumatic brain injury patients.

Dr. Victor Rodgers joined the UCR faculty in 2006. A Fellow of the prestigious American Association for the Advancement of Science, he serves as director of the B2K Group at UCR, which conducts research in: artificial organs, kinetics, drug delivery, bio-separations, and crowded proteins.

Rodgers work is largely interdisciplinary and collaborative with colleagues in medical, pharmaceutical, and bio-science programs. In addition, he mentors K-12 students and encourages their interest in science and engineering; and involves his UCR students in programs that do the same.
