"How Can Routines and Rituals Overcome Our Pandemic Isolation?"



Presentation By: Thomas Kramer

Associate Dean of the Undergraduate Business Program Professor of Marketing, UCR School of Business

Some people call our unique routines and rituals as quirky. Others call them weird. Would you believe that experts actually call these coping mechanisms? Even more so during a pandemic or during periods of isolation.

A UCR study has found people who adopt unique rituals to make everyday tasks more meaningful might feel less lonely. "We found that something as simple as preparing tea in a certain way, as long as it's interpreted as a ritual, can make an experience more meaningful," said UCR professor Thomas Kramer. "Many people are trying to find structure right now because everything is so chaotic," Kramer said. "The implications of our study are that if you feel isolated, find a ritual. It doesn't have to be elaborate. It can help you feel less lonely by providing a sense of meaning and purpose."

Thomas Kramer received his Ph.D. from Stanford and his MBA and Bachelor's degrees from Baruch College, CUNY. Prior to joining UCR in 2015, he was a faculty member at Baruch College and the University of South Carolina. Professor Kramer is currently the Co-Editor of the *Journal of Consumer Psychology*, and has served as Associate

Editor at the Journal of Consumer Research.
